Why are we concerned about the
Vietnamese in Cambodia?



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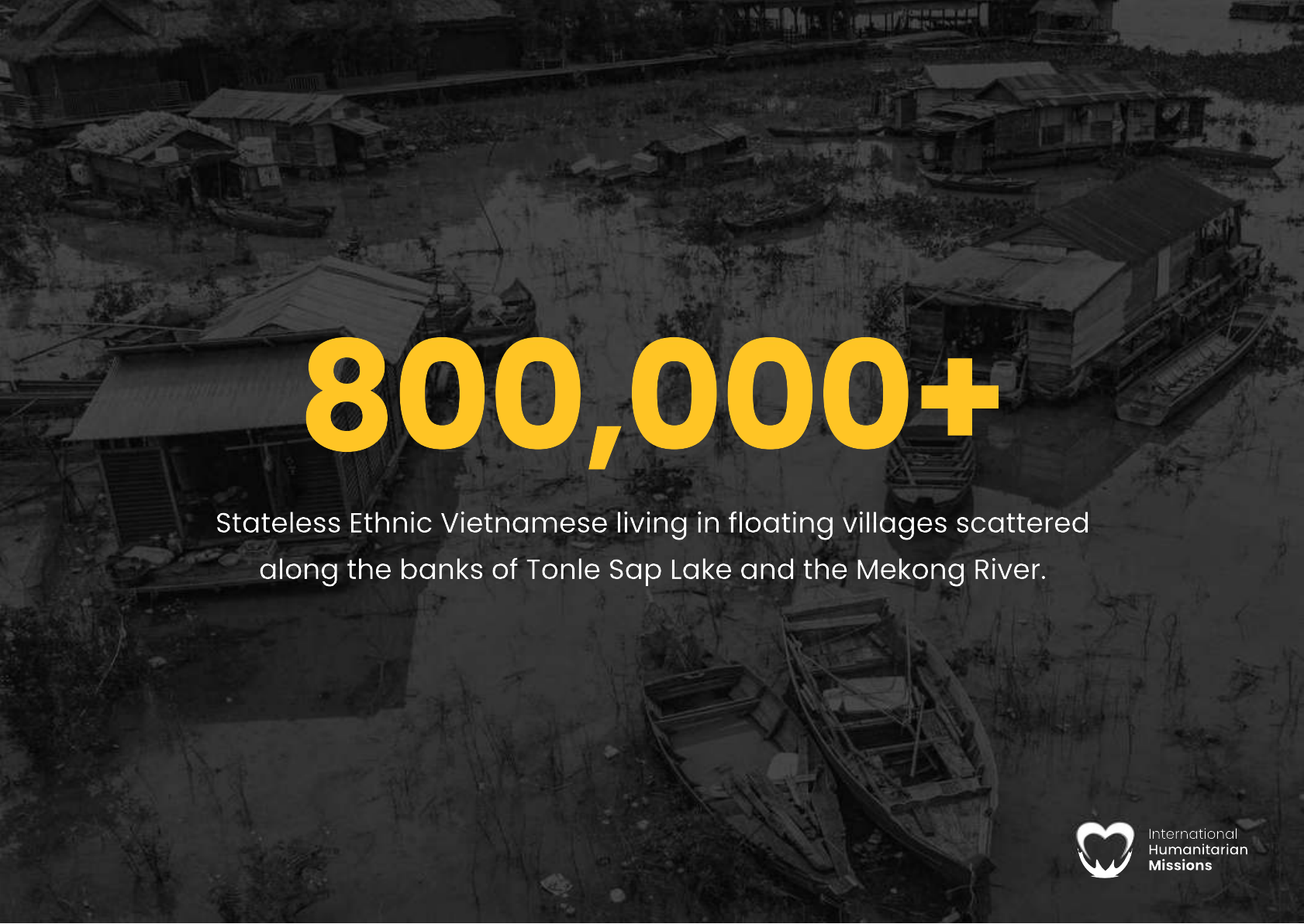
Stateless Ethnic Vietnamese living in Cambodia represent the **largest stateless group** anywhere in the world.

In 2015, CNN exposed Svay Pak as the **child prostitution capital** of the world.

The children sold on the streets of Svay Pak are **mostly Vietnamese**.

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Racial divisions and discrimination

- They cannot obtain citizenship.
- They cannot own land, access healthcare and social services, attend school, or get a job.
- Highest risk of human trafficking & forced prostitution.
- Recently, those living in the floating villages, many for three generations, were **forcibly evicted from the Lake**.
- They had nowhere to go.
- The policy of eviction without proper resettlement was inhumane.



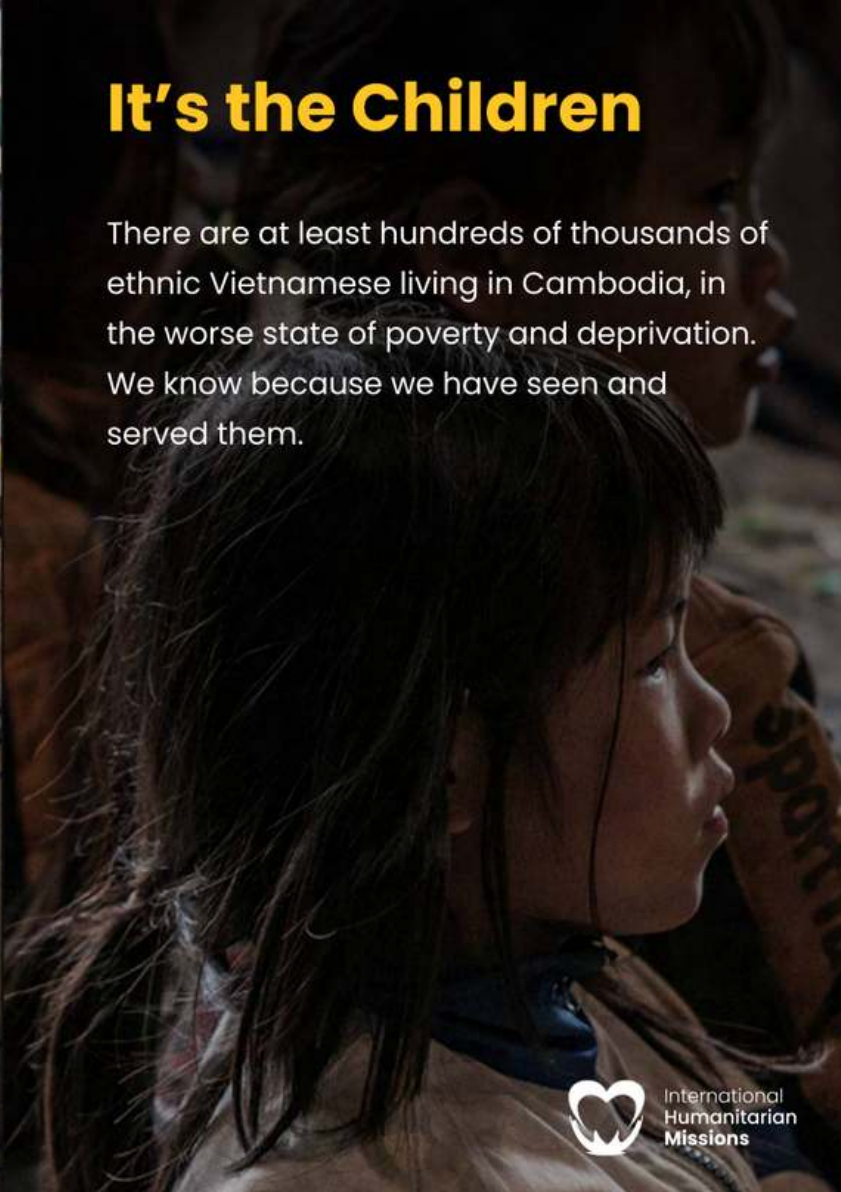


No basic Human Rights

There are at least hundreds of thousands of ethnic Vietnamese living in Cambodia, in the worse state of poverty and deprivation. We know because we have seen and served them.



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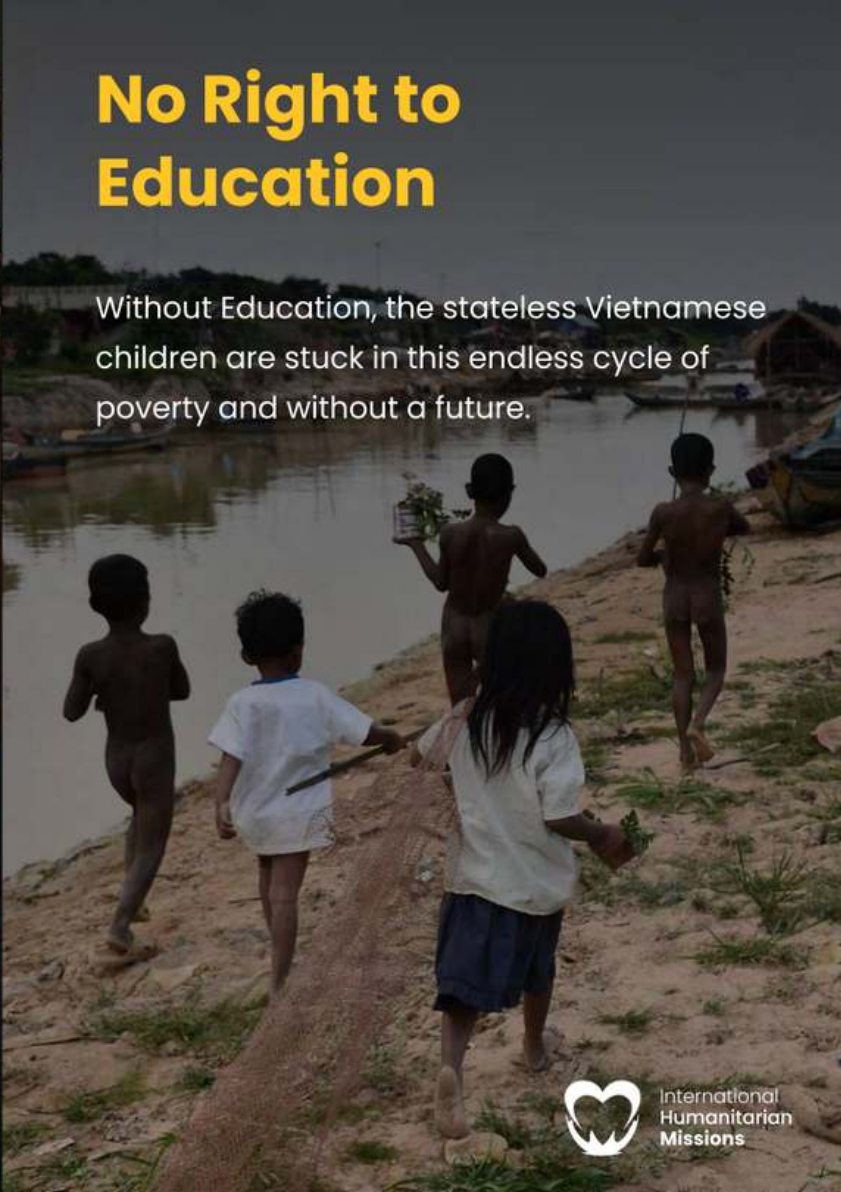


How Do We Know?

Most have never seen a doctor. No vaccinations. Children starts working as fish processor from 9-10 years old. Children of all ages have only attended 1st grade.

No Right to Education

Without Education, the stateless Vietnamese children are stuck in this endless cycle of poverty and without a future.

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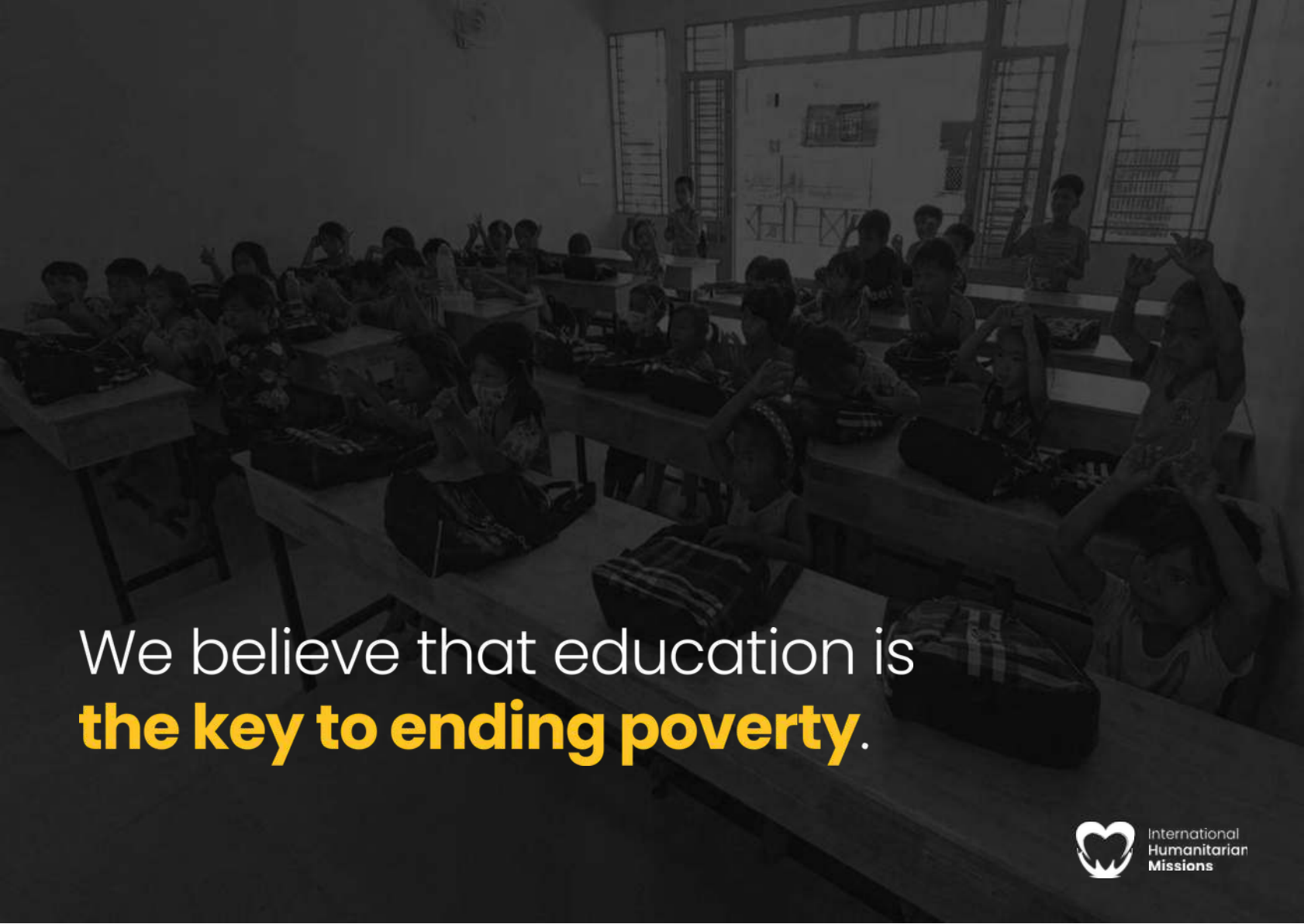


"I'm so happy I got a new backpack and colorful books today. **I've been waiting to go to school for so long,**"
